You will be helping with clerical duties and helping families move through the vaccination process easily and effectively. Each location is set up a bit differently, but the core volunteer jobs are always the same. The volunteer packets have detailed information for each position. Please ask staff or the volunteer supervisor if you have questions.

Always let someone know if you need a restroom or snack break. Always let volunteer supervisor know when you are leaving the event. Be sure to sign in and sign out at the volunteer table.

Volunteers DO:

- 1. Greet and direct the family to Registration to pick up forms
- 2. Review Registration forms for completeness, help family complete form, if needed
- 3. Photocopy shot records
- 4. Record lot numbers of selected vaccines onto client registration form
- 5. Stand as line guides to help families navigate the process
- 6. Learn about Public Health initiatives about immunizations
- 7. Receive and wear a Be Wise Immunize T-shirt
- 8. Supervise the after-vaccine waiting area, and ask (sometimes) families to fill out a survey

Volunteers DO NOT:

- 1. Give shots.
- 2. Read shot records.
- 3. Give vaccine advice.
- 4. Accept payment for vaccines
- 5. Handle medical emergencies
