Immunization Collaboration of Tarrant County Be Wise—Immunize Volunteer Q & A

What Volunteers DO:

- Hand out and explain registration forms – one form per child – ask family Spanish or English
- Hand out ASN (adult safety net forms) to those 19 yrs and older who have no health insurance.
- Review registration form for completeness, help family complete form if needed.
- Make copies of shot records
- Copy Lot numbers of selected vaccines (after TCPH reader reviews shot record) onto client registration form
- Volunteers help with crowd management. Help maintain an orderly process and lining up of families. Assist families with multiple children before and after vaccines.
- Line Guides assure each family attends all of the stations in the process.
- Volunteers will learn about Public health initiatives around immunizations.
- All Volunteers receive Be Wise—Immunize T-shirts
- Water, snacks provided to volunteers. Lunch when working 4 hours or more.
- ****ARRIVE 15 – 20 minutes before shift begins, for “Just In Time” training. Closing is after All families in the door at scheduled clinic end are served.**

Volunteers DO NOT:

- Give shots. **All vaccines are given by Tarrant County Public Health Department**
- Read shot records.
- Give vaccine advice.
- Handle medical emergencies
